Reconfirm the current instructional delivery method:
All K-12 general education instruction transitioned from being fully remote to being hybrid (2-day in-person) with a fully remote option on Monday, January 25, 2021.
Reconfirm whether or not the district is offering higher levels of in-person instruction for English language learners, special education students, or other special populations:
K-8 special education students in basic classrooms are receiving full-day, in-person (4-day in-person) instruction as of Monday, January 25, 2021. High school basic classroom students have transitioned to being hybrid (2-day in-person) as of Monday, January 25, 2021.
