students cannot drive.

Deb Disbro, Special Education Director, presented on the Timely IEP data. For the year monitored we had 7 students who had two IEPS in one year that the computer did not read the data accurately. When we uploaded the first IEP showing the timely IEP was met, we made a clerical error and sent the wrong IEP for one student. That student did have a timely IEP, thus no cross indicator analysis was needed.
