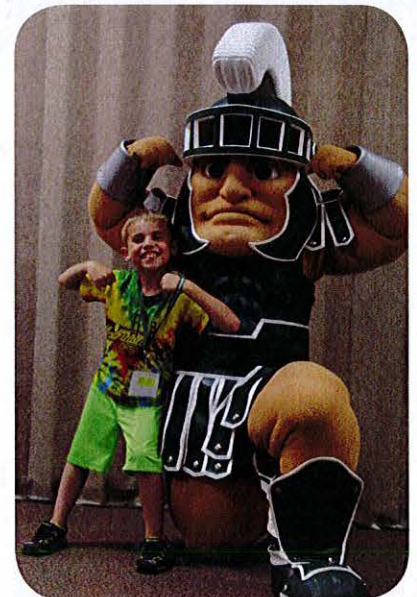
**GUPPY @ MSU**

Gifted University for Parents and Precocious Youth

Grades 3-4: June 30-July 1, 2018

Grades: 5-6: June 29-July 1, 2018

GUPPY is designed for young gifted students to attend MSU for a weekend and take classes with faculty. There are two sessions: grades 3-4 is two days and grades 5-6 is three days. GUPPY offers a variety of accelerated exploratory educational presentations and hands-on experiences in MSU's laboratories and classrooms. Topics include from STEAM curriculum and pre-medical topics. Families living a distance from campus may stay overnight at a locally prearranged hotel with their student, at a special MSU rate. Local families may drop off and pick up their student each day.



**CSI: FORENSIC SCIENCE CAMP**

June 24-29, 2018 Current grades 7-9

This program gives students insight into what it takes to be a crime scene investigator through interacting with forensic science professionals in a variety of specialties. Students will apply their investigative skills and creativity to analyze mock crime scenes using real forensic science equipment.
