Amo Linguam Latinam
(I Love Latin!)

Students studying Latin typically have improved SAT scores. Every semester of the program would correspond with one year of high school Language Arts/ Latin emphasizing development while refining reading and writing skills. Discussion of language will be anchored in Roman and medieval culture, as well as regular conversations about linguistics and the role Latin has played in the development of the English language. Students would take the National Latin Exam at the end of each year, and the AP Latin exam at the end of their second year.

CHAMP

Cooperative Highly Accelerated
Math Program

Highly advanced mathematics students have the opportunity to get a jump on the competition through the CHAMP Program! With weekly classes held on MSU's campus, CHAMP is an academic year-long program designed to teach students the required four-year high school mathematics curriculum in just two years. First year students will study Algebra I & II, while second year students study Geometry and Pre-Calculus.

Intensive Study in Humanities,
Arts, Language and Literature

Academically advanced readers will study a wide range of texts and media in literature and the humanities including novels, biographies, plays, poetry, and film. Students are also exposed to variety of different historical movements and types of literature, such as romanticism, enlightenment, Shakespearean drama and comedy, in addition to modern works. The ISHALL program covers four years of high school English curriculum in just two academic years. In a small classroom environment intended to foster discussion but allow for individualized attention, students will study texts and media from a variety of genres and historical movements.

Students with a passion for French language and culture can complete four years of high school French curriculum in just two academic years. LEAF has a small classroom environment, intended to allow time for plenty of speech practice and individualized attention.

In LEAF 2, students will prepare with their instructors to take the AP French Exam.
