This exciting opportunity will pair a middle school student with a Veteran living at Green Acres. The first session will be the interview where you will get to learn all about the life and adventures of your Veteran. In the following two sessions, you will turn your interview notes and information into a personal biography of your Veteran. Each Veteran will be presented with a copy of their story, and an anthology copy will be placed in Green Acres, Mason Middle School's library, and a few other surprise locations in Mason.

Students who sign up must be available for all three sessions, be comfortable speaking with others, and be interested in writing. Ms. Brickey, 8th grade ELA teacher and author, will be leading and assisting this project. Sign up and learn about the life and times of a local Veteran, hone your listening and writing skills, and share in the building of community pride. Cost covers all 3 dates.
