2015-16 STAFFING UPDATE

There were no staffing updates for the 2015-16 school year. Recruitment issues continue.

PROFESSIONAL LEARNING COMMUNITIES (PLCs)

Implementation of Professional Learning Communities for 2015-16 was discussed. Continued discussion regarding the planning of Professional Learning Communities will take place. The committee discussed the possibility of starting school one hour late on Wednesdays. PLCs may be implemented this fall. Superintendent Drzewicki provided examples of Professional Learning Communities.

2016-17 STAFFING

An additional section of kindergarten may be added next year based on kindergarten registration numbers. Current kindergarten classes average 26-27 students per classroom.

If the bond does not pass, it will be necessary to use portable classrooms. An additional fifth grade section will be a necessity at Alaiedon in the fall of 2016-17.
