Grades 1-3 Jump Start Program

Mr. Stuard provided the committee with an update of the Jump Start summer program available for grades 1-3. This literacy focused program was led by 13 teachers and impacted more than 140 elementary students.

Mr. Stuard provided the committee with a K-5 Literacy update, including upcoming informational session on the district's ELA program and Reading Street.
